## WHAT'S NEW?

### NO MORE FINES

For most items, if you have material overdue, you simply need to renew or return it before you place a hold or borrow additional items.

### BOOK STUDY ROOMS ONLINE

Go online to book a library study room for up to 2 hours at a time, then stop by the Borrower Services to check out a room key.

### HOLDS PICK-UP

Place a hold on material in our catalogue, and after you get an email telling you it is ready for pick up, stop by the Borrower Services counter with your ID. For many items, this is a same-day service.

### VISIT THE RENOVATED LOWER LEVEL

New lighting and a polished concrete floor—you will never call it “the dungeon” again.

### SCAN AND DELIVER

If you are studying from a distance and need an excerpt from an item in our print or microform collections, we can send you a copyright compliant PDF within 3 days.

### WELCOME THE INKLINGS

Watch for news about a significant collection of rare C. S. Lewis and friends materials finding a home at Alloway Library.

### INTERLIBRARY LOANS

ILL is a formal agreement among academic libraries that enable TWU students, faculty and staff to obtain materials not owned by the TWU Library

### ACCESS OTHER LIBRARIES

Use a COPPUL card from Borrower Services to **borrow from other post-secondary libraries in Canada**, or place an Interlibrary Loan to have materials sent here.
